

Jesus Wept

During our lifetime, we will be confronted with trials and struggles that will sometimes test us beyond measure. Does Jesus care when we suffer, carry a heavy burden in this life, or mourn the loss of a loved one??? Yes! We have a loving Savior, who truly cares, when we are hurting and all else seems to fail us. We learn as much from the death of Lazarus.

"Then, when Mary came where Jesus was, and saw Him, she fell down at His feet, saying to Him, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died." Therefore, when Jesus saw her weeping, and the Jews who came with her weeping, He groaned in the spirit and was troubled. And He said, "Where have you laid him?" They said to Him, "Lord, come and see." Jesus wept. Then the Jews said, "See how He loved him!" John 11:32-36

We learned at an early age, this is the shortest verse in the Bible: "Jesus wept."

Jesus is our good shepherd! He showed heartfelt compassion, because He, too, suffered while in the flesh (Heb. 5:8) Yes, He cares! Jesus so loved His sheep (disciples) that He was willing to lay down His life for the flock. "I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd gives his life for the sheep" - John 10:11

As children of God, we never carry our burdens alone. When the load seems too great, thanks be to Him, God, who provides a way of escape for us!

"Cast your burden on the Lord, and He shall sustain you," Psalm 55:22

His heart is touched with my grief;
When the days are weary,

When the road becomes too difficult, when trials seem too great, we serve a God who mercifully provides us with strength and a place of refuge. Cast your cares upon Him! In fact, God has commanded us to ask Him to lift our heavy burdens. And He has promises to provide relief.

"....The Lord is at hand. Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God, and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:6-7

As heavy as our burdens may be at times, seemingly unbearable, imagine how hopeless we would be, if we didn't have the comfort and strength that comes from our God through our faith. God is our refuge and strength. Thanks be to Him for providing us with strength and a place of refuge to escape when we are burdened and weary. In our Lord we can always find mercy and help in times of need. We are comforted in knowing that our God cares for us and will take care of us.

Hebrews 4:14-16
